CRIME PREVENTION ADVISORY FOR THE YEAR END FESTIVE SEASON

The year-end festive season is approaching. This period is an opportune time for criminals to commit theft or theft related offences due to large crowds in shopping malls, commit housebreaking during the closure of commercial premises as well as opportunistic crime such as outrage of modesty and pickpocketing. Commercial premise owners are advised to inform the shop/restaurant owners and other tenants to take precautionary measures such as not to keep cash or valuables inside the shop and install CCTVs where possible.

- The Police would like to reiterate the importance for our stakeholders to remain vigilant against possible crime and security threats to their premises.
